MINUTES OF THE MEETING

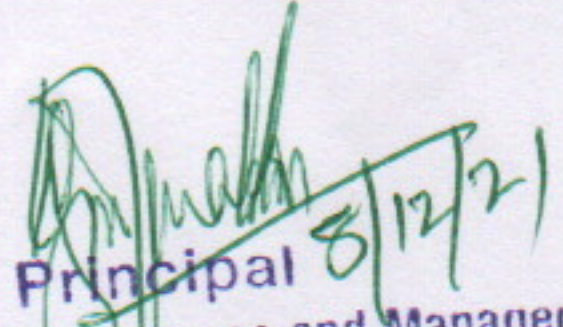
- ❖ Prof Rajan V N, the principal chaired the meeting

The IQAC meeting was held on 27-05-2022 in the Principals chamber at 4.00PM.

Prof Rajan V N, Principal welcomed the members present.

Firstly, the meeting began with, the Principal expressing his gratitude to the coordinator and the staff for successful completion of NAAC First cycle.

Proceedings of the Meeting were as follows:

- 1) Introduction of CA foundation courses for the academic year 2022-23, where our own faculty members will take up the syllabus.
- 2) NAAC EXIT Report was kept forward and NAAC certificate with B grade 2.43 CGPA was presented to all members present at the meeting. 11 suggestions mentioned by the NAAC committee were informed and improvisations on this regard was discussed.
 - ❖ Tally, Code Unnati, UNDP-EDP and Personality development courses are held.
 - ❖ Bridge course/Communicative English classes to be held for the first year students for 10 days.
 - ❖ NAT's exam was conducted, 28 students cleared the exam. The students were trained by the staff and certificates were awarded.
 - ❖ Students have enrolled themselves to the SWAYAM courses and as of now 4 students have cleared.
 - ❖ BCA students are undergoing a hardware and networking course at KGTTI , together with the B.Com students doing their tally course.
- 3) Alumni registration guidelines are formed and registration need to be done, Alumni meet is planned to be held in the month of June.
- 4) Placement drive was held, were 5 company's took part and 11 of our students got selected and training towards placement is provided as of now.
- 5) College has signed 5 MOU's with different institutions for the benefit of the students.
- 6) Infrastructural requirement i.e requirement of classroom, requirement of canteen were brought to the notice of the management and improvisation is assured.
- 7) Research culture:
 - Two staff Prof Roshan and Prof Prashanth have registered for Ph. D. Two staff cleared KSET and NET (Prof Akshatha and Prof Prashanth)
 - Our college physical director qualified for State Referee (Kho-Kho).
- 8) IT Facilities: Requirement of certain facilities was kept forward from the point of BCA Department
 - Requirement of few projectors
 - New computer Lab be established.
 - Requirement of AC to the Lab and more computers
 - WIFI speed to be increased to 75 mbps.

9) Removal of Aviation and Hospitality Course

- Suggestion was given to remove Aviation and Hospitality course as it is not a practical oriented course and students have to again learn elsewhere.
- Introduction of GST course, a UGC career-oriented course.

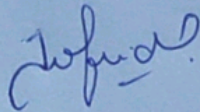
10) It was suggested that students should be motivated to do minor projects, paper presentations.

11) Continuation of best practices: Product Launch and introduction of a new best practice was required.

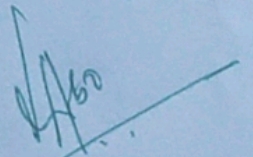
Other points discussed were
