




#### **Blood Donation Camp**

## KONKANI CLUB- ORPHANAGE VISIT ON 4th MARCH 2019






Konkani club members organized to visit old age home, Jeppu. Then we planned to conduct the games, skit and song.


## FLOOD RELIEF AID




## AWARENESS PROGRAM - NSS

#### SEMINAR ON WOMEN AND HEALTH ISSUES



## TALK ON USE OF PLASTIC WASTE



#### SEMINAR ON 'ETIQUETTES'




## WORLD THEATRE DAY
