CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

A Cross Country race was also organized on the eve of Independence Day.

The College Women's Throw Ball Team won second place in Dasara Taluk Level Throwball Match, won the first place at St Aloysius College, won first place at Father Muller Medical College, won first place in Mangalore University inter-Collegiate Women's Throwball and secured the Poorna Prajna College rolling Throphy.

Our College Athletic team participated in the Mangalore University Inter-Collegiate Athletic Meet held at Alvas College, Moodbidri. We provide mid-day meal for the needy students at a subsidized rate. We also have multi-gym facility, a basket ball court and a well equipped computer lab with internet facility in our Campus. I am happy to announce that we inaugurated a new 400 meters track and wash rooms and changing rooms in our Padua Ground

Our students avail different scholarships from various sources. In the academic year scholarship from the Backward Class Welfare Department is Rs 64,590/- and Rs 89,910/-. Merit scholarship from our college is Rs. 96,000/- Fee concession given from the college is Rs.1,03,900/- and sports scholarship given from the college is Rs.40,000/- PTA Scholarship from the College is Rs.67,000/-Till date the total scholarship amount is Rs.4,61,400/-

Though we want to enumerate various achievements of our staff members due to time constraints we will not be reading them out. We will publish them in our annual college magazine.


GRATITUDE
