





NAAC PREPARATION SEMINAR








"POST MODERNISM AND ITS IMPACT ON SOCIETY"

STAFF ORIENTATION PROGRAM







KARNATAKA TULU SAHITHYA ACADEMY





FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM






TALK ON HUMAN RIGHTS – 4TH JANUARY 2019
