

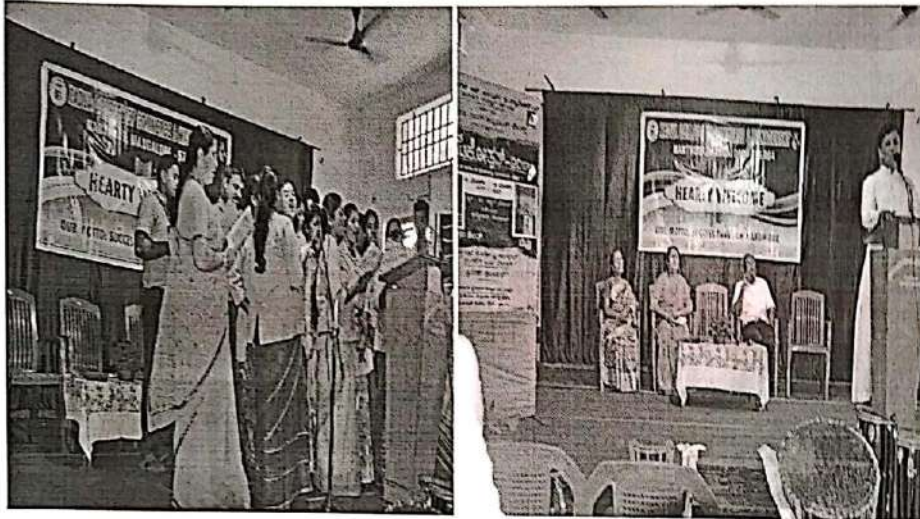
## “ADDICTION AND YOUTH OF TODAY” ✓

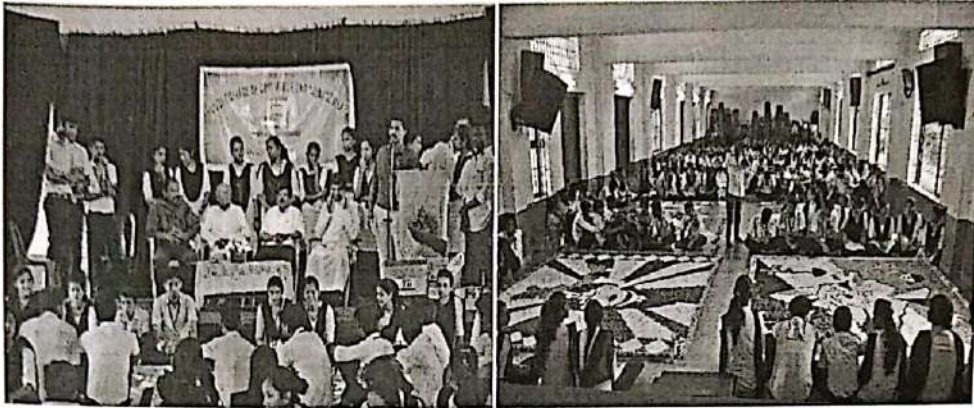
## CROSS COUNTRY RACE

INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION

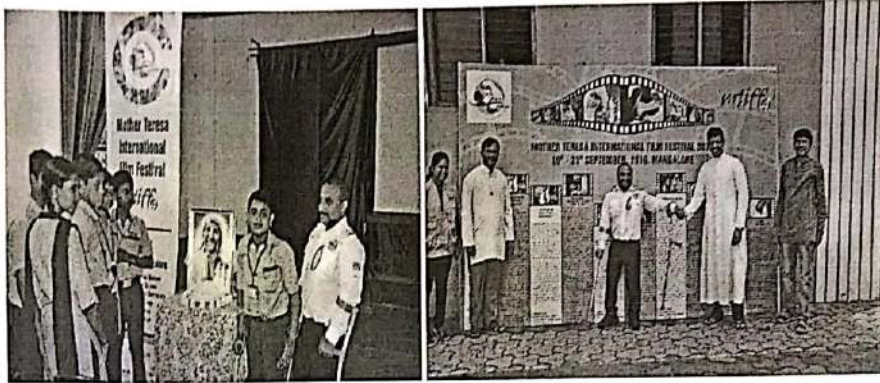

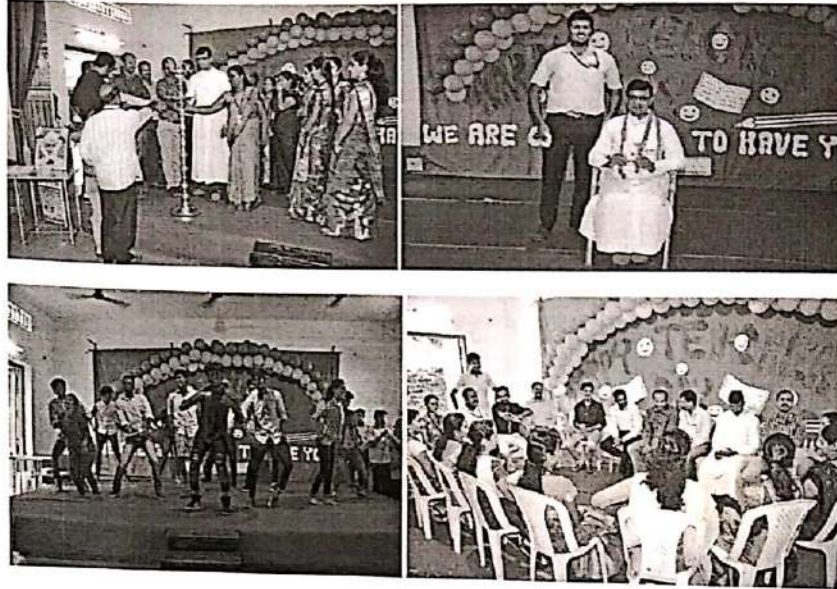

### TEACHER'S DAY CELEBRATION

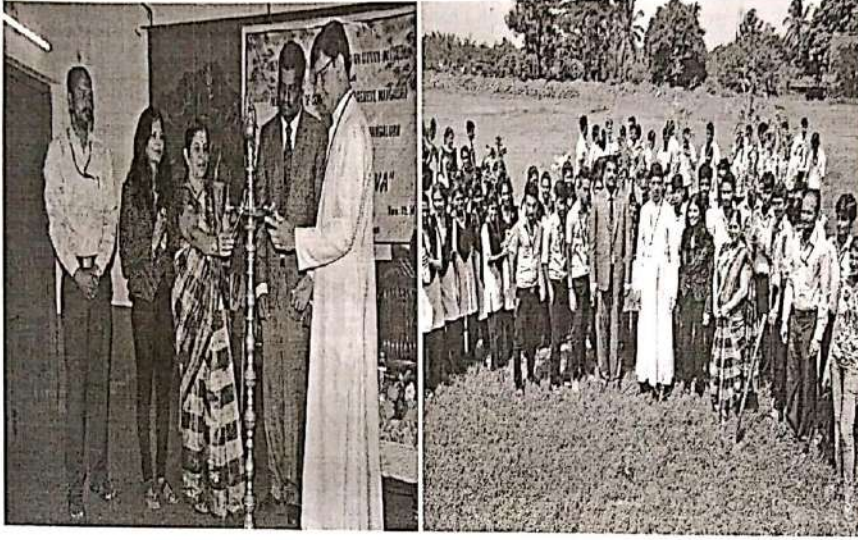

“VANAMAHOTHSAVA”



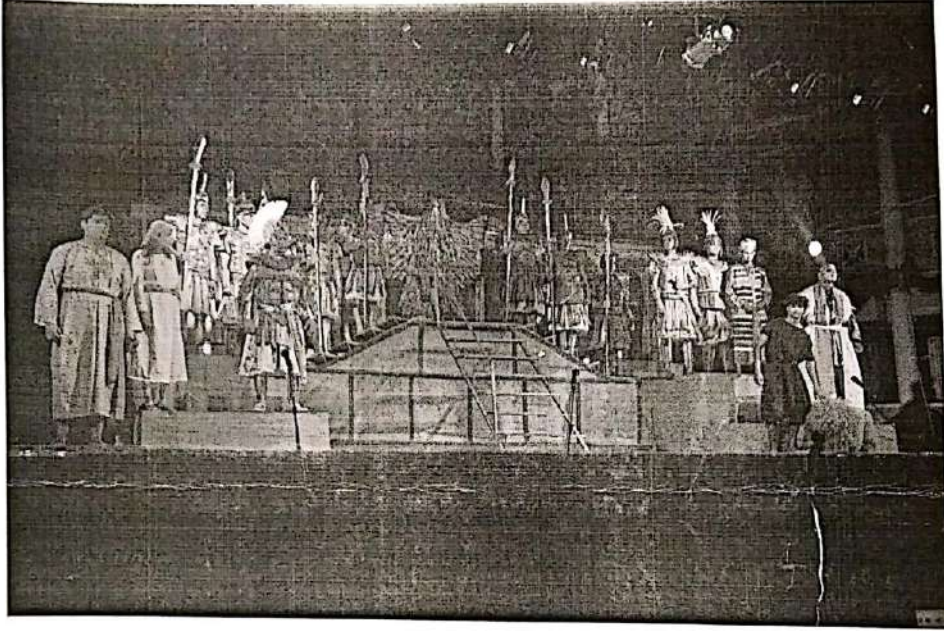
