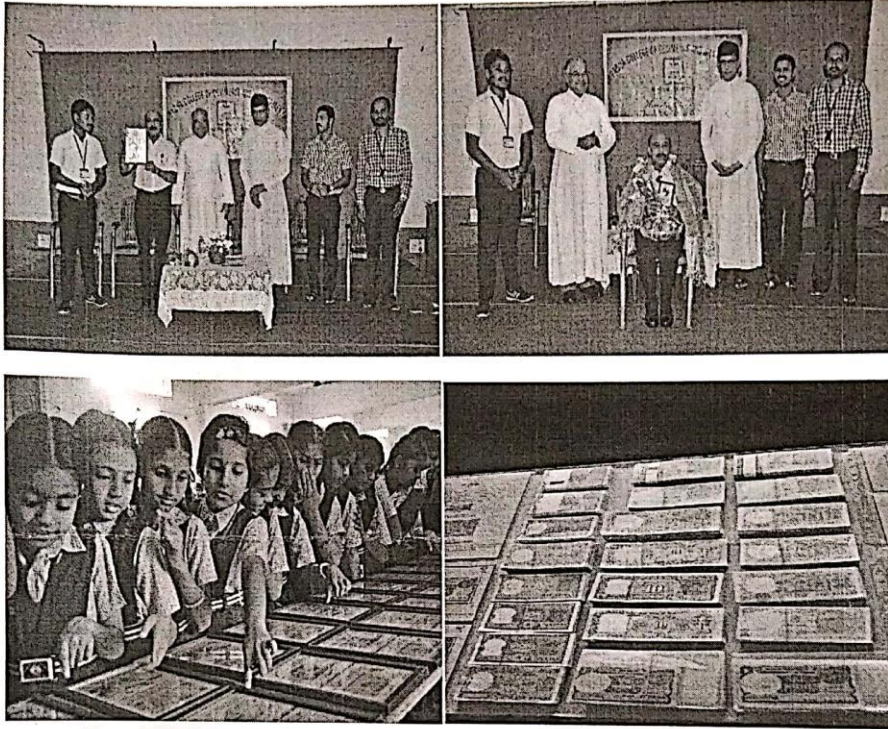


## CURRENCY EXHIBITION ✓

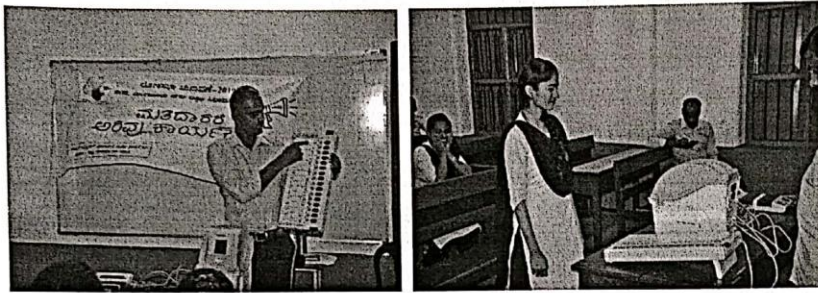



SEMINAR ON FINANCIAL EDUCATION AND CONSUMER AWARENESS ✓

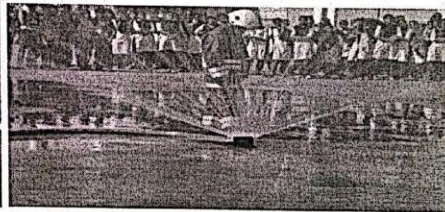
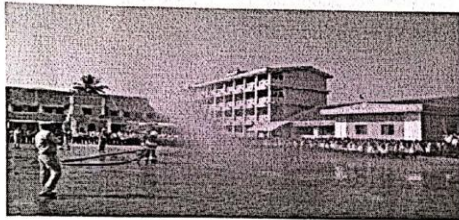

CONDOLENCE PROGRAM TO THE MARTYRED SOLDIERS- 21<sup>ST</sup> FEBRUARY 2019

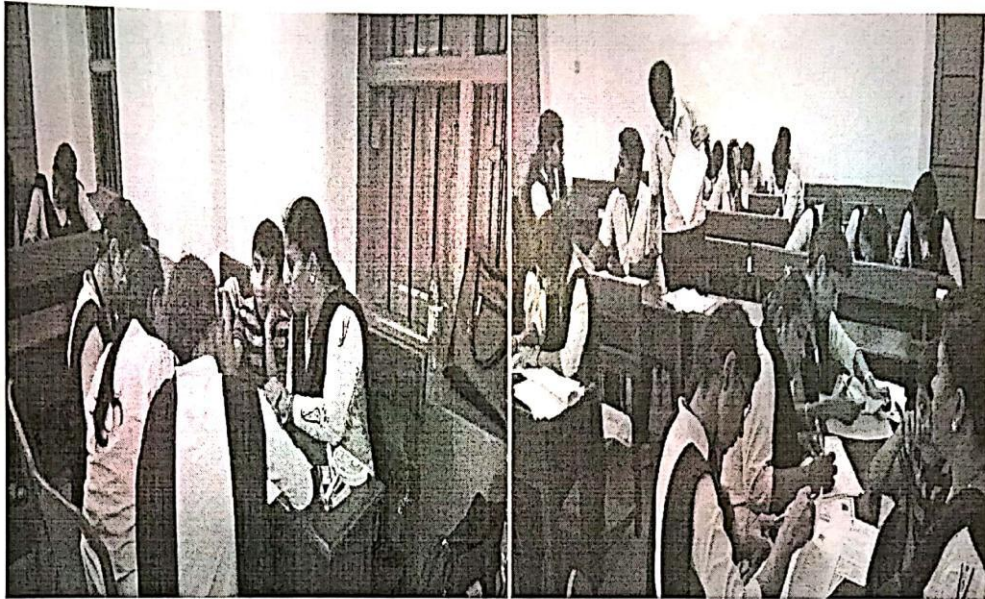

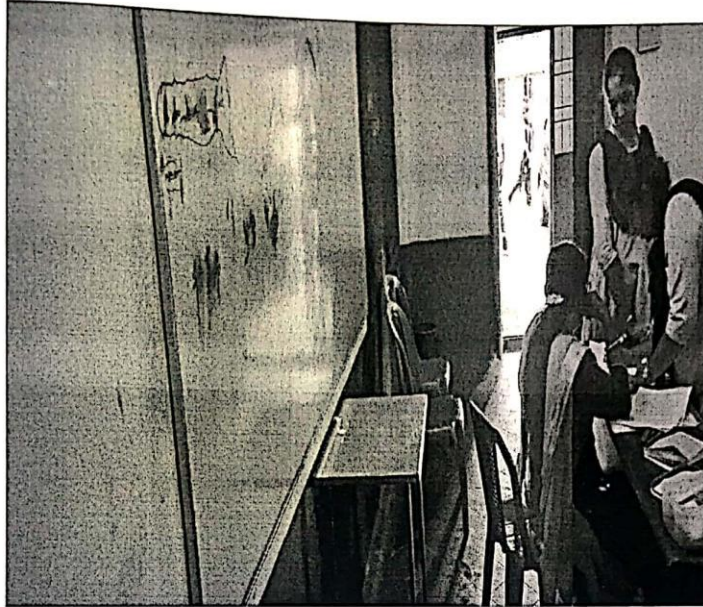
PROCUREMENT OF VOTER ID CARD

## Procurement of PAN card and Passport

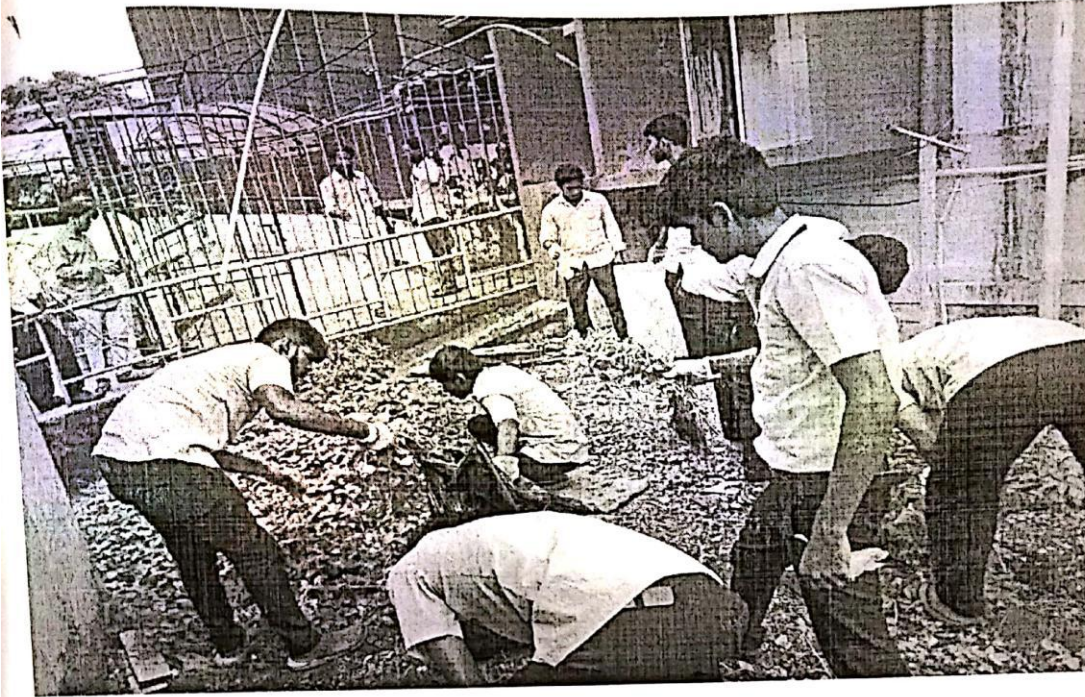

## Shramadhana at Wenlock Hospital



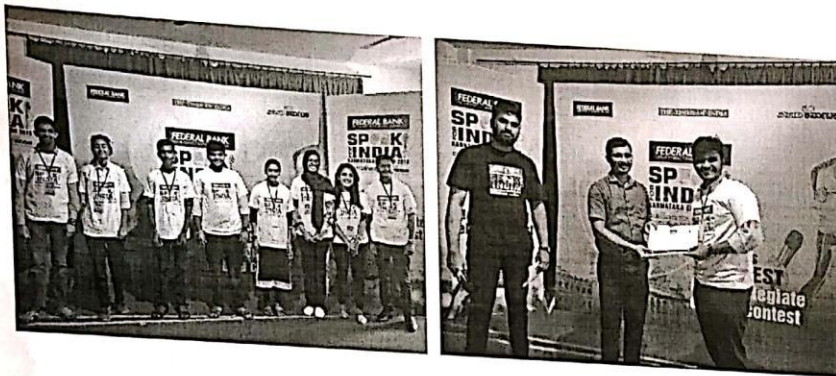

SPEAK FOR INDIA - 22<sup>ND</sup> SEPTEMBER 2018

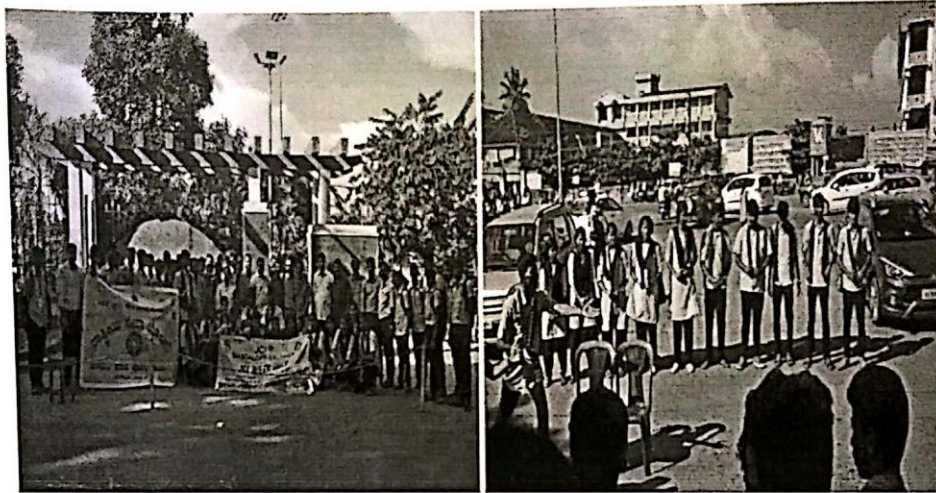

## STREET PLAY- "SAVE WATER"

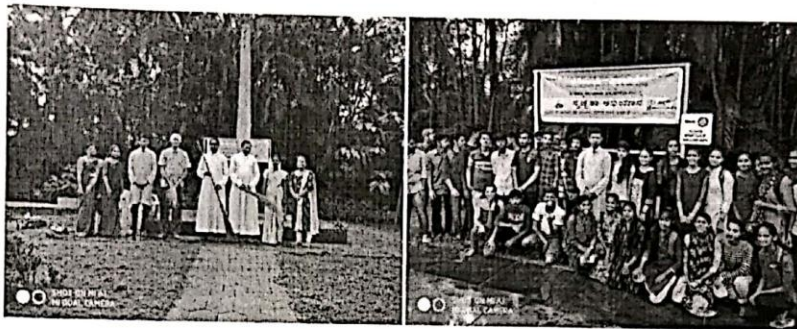



TRAFFIC AWARENESS – 26<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY 2019



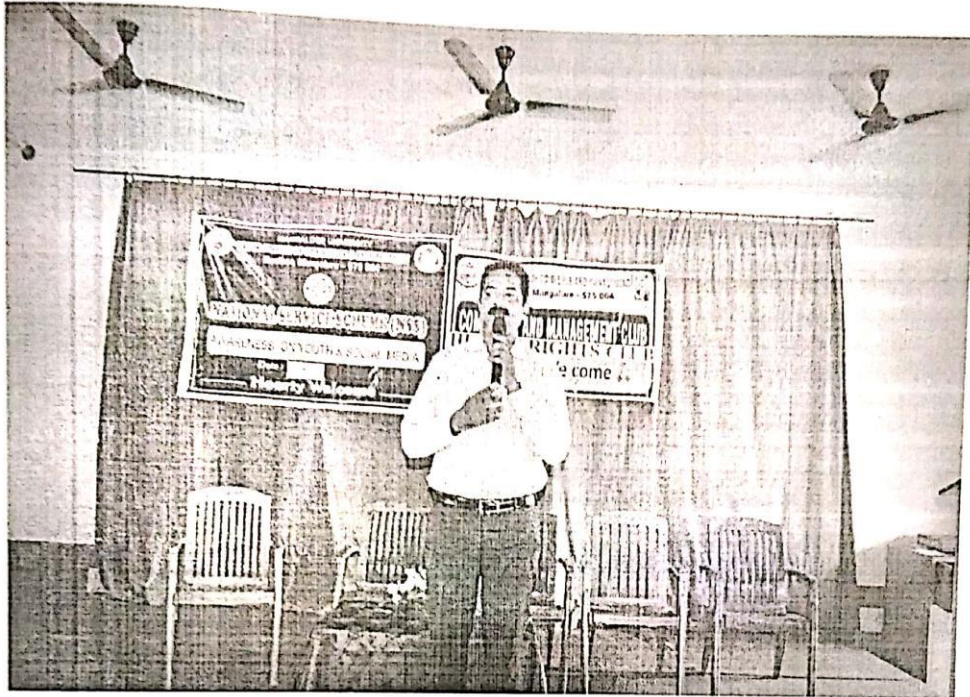
